Meeting Highlights and Action Plan

Agenda Item/ Topic	Key Points	Action Items
Congestive Heart Failure	CHF conduit began 1 st week of February. A few bumps in the road but RH has seen 3 patients so far. SRMC is seeing 6-8 CHF patients per week. RH personnel are calling the patients and collecting information and teaching during the call. Have analytics in place to collect for each patient. Much discussion regarding home care but Medicare restricts home care to homebound. Some of the patients are being sent to the "Health Resource Center." Measure continues to be 30, 60, 90 day readmission rates.	Check on getting home care to do an initial evaluation of the patients. Need to better understand how SRMC is referring CHF patients. Scales could be helpful if there is no other way to get one.
Diabetes	On schedule to have the RHC educators (Cedarville Clinical faculty) get their hours for certification after the hospital gets recertified in September 2017.	Continue to meet the timeline for RHC to be certified as an additional site in September/October 2017.
Asthma	Applied for Asthma resources (pillow covers, mattress covers and door mats) from the Community Health Foundation. Have contacted all physicians involved in Asthma treatment and control and provided our contact information and let them know what services the CCCHD can provide. Anne has had referrals from RHC. Info is on the CCCHD webpage. Next meeting of the subgroup is March 15 th at the CCCHD.	May schedule additional marketing visits to physician's offices. Will continue to provide the visits/consultations. Upcoming provider meeting on April 4 th at SRMC where Anne will represent this issue. Assessment training coming up on March 29 th at RHC. Also planning to contact school nurses via the CCCHD communications.
Oral Health	Community Health Foundation has taken on Oral Health as an initiative. The RHC is hoping to see their first patients in the new dental clinic in September. They will start with their own patients and work on the patient mix. Continued work on the Fluoride initiative. Building committee and trying to see if it will go up for a vote in 2017.	RHC recruiting dental providers and working with consultants to build out the clinic. Build committee to address lack of fluoride in the water supply.
Tobacco	Tobacco Task Force has revised goals and is starting STAND groups in the high schools. Focusing on a video made by students to use on YouTube and using social media. Also working with Springfield Metropolitan Housing Authority for implementation and education relating to the new HUD smoke-free housing rule.	Formation of STAND groups with focus on preventing kids from starting which is much cheaper than cessation. Produce videos for use with high school and middle school students. Providing educational material and choices for Metro Housing tenants.
