Meeting Highlights and Action Plan

Agenda Item/ Topic	Key Points	Action Items
Diabetes	Moving toward an ADA approved site in September. Once one patient has completed the 15 hours of self-education then they will be ready. Patients are being identified internally at RHC. Work flow is set up. External referrals sources are ready such as sleep studies with SRMC. Pharmacists from Cedarville are on board. Donation from CCDA to help pay for the education.	Continue to meet the timeline for RHC to be certified as an additional site in September/October 2017.
CHF	7 CHF referrals, 3 patients seen at RHC with 48-72 hours of discharge.	Need to follow up with Marianne Potina on how many CHF patients w/o a PCP were discharged.
Asthma	Wrote for a grant from the CHP for mattress covers and other asthma control items.	Grant has been awarded and Referrals continue.
Oral Health	The RHC is still on track to see their first patients in the new dental clinic in September. Local family donated funding to build out the clinic. Continued work on the Fluoride initiative but falling behind schedule due to other things on the City Commission agenda such as the Tremont Barrel Fill situation. Chairs in place for the Fluoride Committee, Deanna and Bill Brougher.	RHC recruiting dental providers and working with consultants to build out the clinic. Nail down dates with city Commissioners for ballot issue.
Tobacco	Continuing work with Springfield Metropolitan Housing Authority for implementation of the new HUD smoke-free housing rule. Working with the STAND group at Springfield High toward going Smoke Free on the campus of the high school. The STAND group has completed their YouTube videos and social media advertisements. They also completed 70 store audits and made recommendations regarding placement issues of tobacco materials.	Continue working toward smoke free campus. Providing educational material and cessation choices for Metro Housing tenants.
Discussion/Other	Springfield Foundation is looking at funding CHIP initiatives and has opened the grant cycle for this year. Next meeting August 21, 2017 and 8 AM at the Rocking Horse Center
