- We have good momentum. We believe the program will gain more momentum after Tecumseh MS and Miami View give their testimony
- Post survey from Wellspring for Botvin will hopefully be available January-February.
- CTC is also interested in getting trained for implementation in the High school
- Grads is interested as well
- Funding currently provided through the Community Health Foundation, Mental Health and Recovery Board and United Way
- Train the trainer; you have to teach for a year before you can train.
- Dr. Hill interested in incorporating Botvin in Dare for SCS but this is dependent on buy-in from the new SPD Chief
