The Clark County Community Health improvement plan 2016-2019 incorrectly stated “The task force purchased the Botvin curriculum and funded trainers to teach this program to select school personnel.” It should read: The Botvin curriculum was purchased with funding from the Community Health Foundation and the United Way. The Mental Health & Recovery Board of Clark, Madison and Greene Counties funded the trainings for Botvin teachers. It needs to be clarified that the Tecumseh District plans to implement Botvin in their Donnelsville Elementary school. • Kyle Johnson plans to take the Botvin training in hopes of adding it to Springfield City Schools. • Working to get a meeting scheduled with Chief Graf and Dr. Hill. • Wellspring is looking to apply for a federal grant to implement Botvin in the middle schools throughout city and county. • Catholic Central will have a training on May 29th and the other schools will be May 14th. • After the May trainings Leslie will have new numbers and information for the goal. • Kyle Johnson and Leslie presented Botvin to the Springfield Police Dept. • There was a discussion on 60 Minutes about suicide.
