The scheduled site for the exercise is the Montgomery County Fairgrounds. This group is invited to participate. The region is looking to Clark County to supply mental/behavioral health workers to be part of the exercise. • Greta attended a conference titled “Lock – Down producers and definitions” by Ret./Sgt. Jesus M. Villahermosa Jr. from Washington DC. Greta is interested in bringing Jesus to Clark County • ESC was hoping to put a school safety/mental health levy on the ballot in May to fund mental health services in the schools. As of last Friday, that is not going to happen due to cost. Greta stated they will continue to pursue methods for supporting mental health services in the schools. Greta’s thought is to bring Crisis Reality Training Inc. to Clark County, Dan Bennett is on board. • Sue stated that Ken Johnson could tell Greta who the players were at last month’s active shooter training. Maybe they would like to be invited to the Crisis Reality Training. Sandy suggested contacting David Gerstner who is the MMRS/RMRS/EP Coordinator for Fire and EMS in the region. He coordinates many of the Active Shooter trainings with Law – Enforcement and the EMS Rescue Task Force.
