<b>Review of 2013 goals</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Nick provided data on suicide by age group and reported Mental Health issues primary goal is those at risk and not receiving services.</li> </ul>	
<b>Strategy for Goal 1</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Implementation of PAX has shown an improvement in the city school students since started in 2013. It is an evidence-based practice.</li> <li>School target populations - A) gain consensus and implement a legally valid, HIPAA compliant universal informational exchange procedure for student referrals to Mental Health Services. B) Review best practices, develop and implement a screening process and case management guidance for reported incidents of suicidal ideation to the student population.</li> <li>Mark and Sue discussed the county schools' Crisis Response Plan/Emergency Response Plan - many plans are under revision. We have an opportunity to incorporate policy directed at management of mental health issues with both students and parents.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Continue PAX GBG in the schools and expand the program to include more grades and schools.</li> <li>✓ Tecumseh has a model plan so they are sharing with any school willing to adopt it.</li> </ul>
<b>Strategy for Goal 2</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Paramedicine program to encourage compliance among those who frequently seek EMS services.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Research guidance on best practices and scope of practice for personnel</li> <li>✓ Work with Springfield Fire Division to recruit and train interested personnel</li> </ul>
<b>Strategy for Goal 3</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Beginning focus group today with white males of target age groups 45-65 years old with a cross section between those served at the Springfield Soup Kitchen and McKinley. Groups will have 10-12 males each and will receive resource packets and incentives for attending.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Implement and complete focus group study of adult population, compile and review data. Need to establish completion date of studies and estimated date of data availability.</li> <li>✓ G. Jones, F. Stegner, and G. Mayer will work on focus group tasks.</li> </ul>

<p><b>Data</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Nick suggested everyone search through the data available on the ccchd.com website. Sue stated that Tammy Collins had mentioned models for suicide prevention in school-age children. These are evidence-based programs designed to implement in the schools.
