Males and females? After some discussion it was decided this committee will focus on the middle-age male population which is the highest risk group.</li> <li>• Data was collected from two groups in this target population. The sites used were The Springfield Soup Kitchen and McKinley Hall. Greta will present the data once it is compiled and analyzed.</li> <li>• We need to look at other areas to obtain a better cross-section in our community.</li> <li>• What agencies and organizations might be good locations for data collection? How do we collect the data? What source(s) is available for data collection?               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Locations for male groups: Phoenix Camp, Churches, SRMC–ED, Springfield Soup Kitchen, Fatherhood Initiative, IHN, Salvation Army, St. John’s, the jail, Ohio Means Jobs, and maybe some work sites. Currently scheduling with a group from the Elks Club.</li> <li>-Survey sources: UCLA, ACE, PHQ9, Trauma Form, BRFSS. The MHRB has their own online depression survey we can pull data from.
