| Revised "Clark<br>County Consent for<br>Release of<br>Information" | <ul> <li>The Superintendents are all on board.</li> <li>Need all city and county schools to use the new release form.</li> <li>Schools are looking for a plan to use on the counselor side.</li> <li>The other issue is that Children are going to the Children's hospitals in Dayton and Columbus. They may not accept this consent form if it doesn't have their name listed. Someone will have to be very specific if they mark "other."</li> <li>Physicians have 30 days post-discharge to complete their paperwork. Sometimes you have to submit a release multiple times.</li> <li>Explaining to parents the reason for the release form.</li> <li>It would be helpful to have a Nationwide Children's contact person for Pediatrics Associates in Springfield.</li> <li>Form needs better instructions</li> <li>Could we have one online location to house the completed consent that could be accessed by all of us?</li> <li>Make another release specifically for hospitals? We are dealing with two different issues. One request is to obtain permission to share information. The other request is to obtain records.</li> <li>The mental health release form has a place to mark whether the information received was written or verbal.</li> <li>Offer a 15 minute mental health in-service for school staff every 1-2 months.</li> </ul> | FCFC will add it to the agenda in June and ask Mr. Patterson to speak on this plan. List the Children's hospitals on the release form and include address and fax numbers. Sue offered to help the districts develop their own request for information.  Dave Lyle at Springfield City schools will email their plan for when a student expresses suicidal ideations.  This form is not what we need for hospitals. Sue will give examples of hospital forms. We still need one universal form to use in Clark County. |

| PAX / Life skills   | Where does PAX fit in? It fits in with this group. It is an evidence based program that was started through the 2013-'15 Mental Health Task Force. PAX is effective for elementary and younger junior high. If it's implemented at a younger age, it will be ingrained in them by age 16.  Life skill – Stacy Lock presented the life skills program at the FCFC meeting. Looking for funding for next school year. Life skills address alcohol use and drug prevention, healthy prenatal choices. Grants available such as the mentoring grant. | Anyone can teach life skills after taking the training. The school can choose a teacher that is familiar with the students or they can have someone from outside the school come and teach. |  |
