Need Superintends to get involved in this program. Need Funding Need one school to pilot program. Botvin Life Skills is a middle school program for 7 th & 8 th grade students. Moved the timelines back to October for meeting with superintendents and training the personnel	Mark Lane agreed to go with MHS to talk to the Superintendents. A meeting has not been set up due to summer break.
Adult Initiative	Wording for the LOSS team needs to be changed to MRC LOSS team. The Resource Cards for the Gatekeepers will be the tool used to evaluate how many persons are referred to MH and how many of those actually sought services. We need to survey physicians to determine how many of their patients are being treated for mental illness, depression, how many are referred to MH and what triggers a referral.
