At the event they offered basic health screenings and mammograms. They received positive feedback from participants. In the future, the planning committee wants to increase the number/types of screenings offered. They have also discussed adding in experts on homeopathic/alternative medicine. • J. Elder also shared that Community Health Foundation is working on a “Speaker Series” with Wittenberg. The first event will be in early December, when an employee from Nationwide Children’s Hospital visits to speak on Health Equity. • C. Young shared that she recently met with Charles Patterson of the CCCHD to discuss marketing for the Oral Health initiative. She also mentioned that the Service Day planning committee will begin meeting in the next few weeks. Service Day will occur in April of 2017. The Black History Month committee is working to plan an event and is interested in bringing in Ron Finely from Los Angeles to speak. They are working on determining his speaker fees. • C. | Revisit Survey Results, Action Items | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The group discussed the themes of the survey results: transportation, price as a barrier and education. C. Young suggested that a big issue is communication and marketing of services. The group discussed creating a bookmark, magnet, pamphlet or other outreach item that identifies transportation opportunities in the county. Action items: 1) research transportation in Clark County 2) identify popular destinations 3) Cost of services 4) Identify gaps The group also discussed how churches could play a role: members could volunteer to offer transportation to grocery store utilizing a shuttle infrastructure. In regards to education, C. Williams explained that WIC is reworking their nutrition education plan for clients. They will be offering a "Nutrition Education Day" for their clients to meet their education requirement. They will learn about meal planning, receive cookbooks and recipe cards. C. Young suggested we could plan a "Chopped" food competition fundraiser.
