Community Crisis Management Plan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Andrea from Catholic Central had a successful use of the plan!! • Leslie and Sue presented at the last Superintendent’s meeting. Dr. Hill asked that it be in electronic format. Barriers discussed: how to finance it, support legally such as IEP and counseling, by law people have to have an assessments. Keep bringing revisions to the table. • Further steps: keep pushing it out. Make parents responsible to fill it out if child goes to hospital. 	
Mental health response to student death	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Principal Ally Thurman was very pleased with the outcome of support they had for this situation. A Student was killed in a car accident the first day of Christmas break. • The viewing and funeral was at Northeastern High School, it was open casket. Some students didn’t know how to handle death, Mrs. Thurman suggests maybe having a grief support room for those students. They had 2 students that came without parents. • Counselor Jane Warren wanted to say Thank you for all the support. She feels ill prepare for this type of situation, she was very pleased to walk in and see all the support. Jane was very thankful to Joe Brumfield for staying and helping the wrestling team. Jane asked if the community has any kind of grief support for the family? Sue stated that Littleton and Rue used to offer a group setting and mental health can offer counseling. For Mental Health services, they will have to go through intake for billing purposes. Community Mercy health partners offers grief support as well. • Ken suggested creating a grief support list. Ken spoke about the NOVA CRT model they responded to this situation. Ken feels the CRT should have done more for the staff. 	

YRBS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Christina Conover went over 2015 Depression and Suicide data. They cross-reference questions from the YRBS to come up with five suicidal ideation risk factors. 	
SRMC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Alice from SRMC is one of the behavioral health RN's. The behavioral health RN's work in the SRMC ED from noon -12:30am. They have found that Clark County has a minimal resource for kids. The ED volume is up and down. The behavioral health RN's do assessments and move them through. Sue is trying to work on a plan for kids, to have a pediatric mental health worker in the ED. There are no licensed beds for kids at SRMC. 	
Handle with Care	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Leslie and Sue rolled it out at the superintendent meeting. Handle with Care form is used when the cops have been dispatched to the child's home, the form is used to inform the school that there was a situation at the home and to please handle this child with care. 	
CRT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ken stated that we are in the process of developing NOVA CRT team in Clark County and plan to formalize it in the next meeting. 	
Botvin Pax GBG Plan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Leslie stated Botvin progress is on hold until she hears from Champaign County Greta stated that they applied for more funding to expand PAX.
