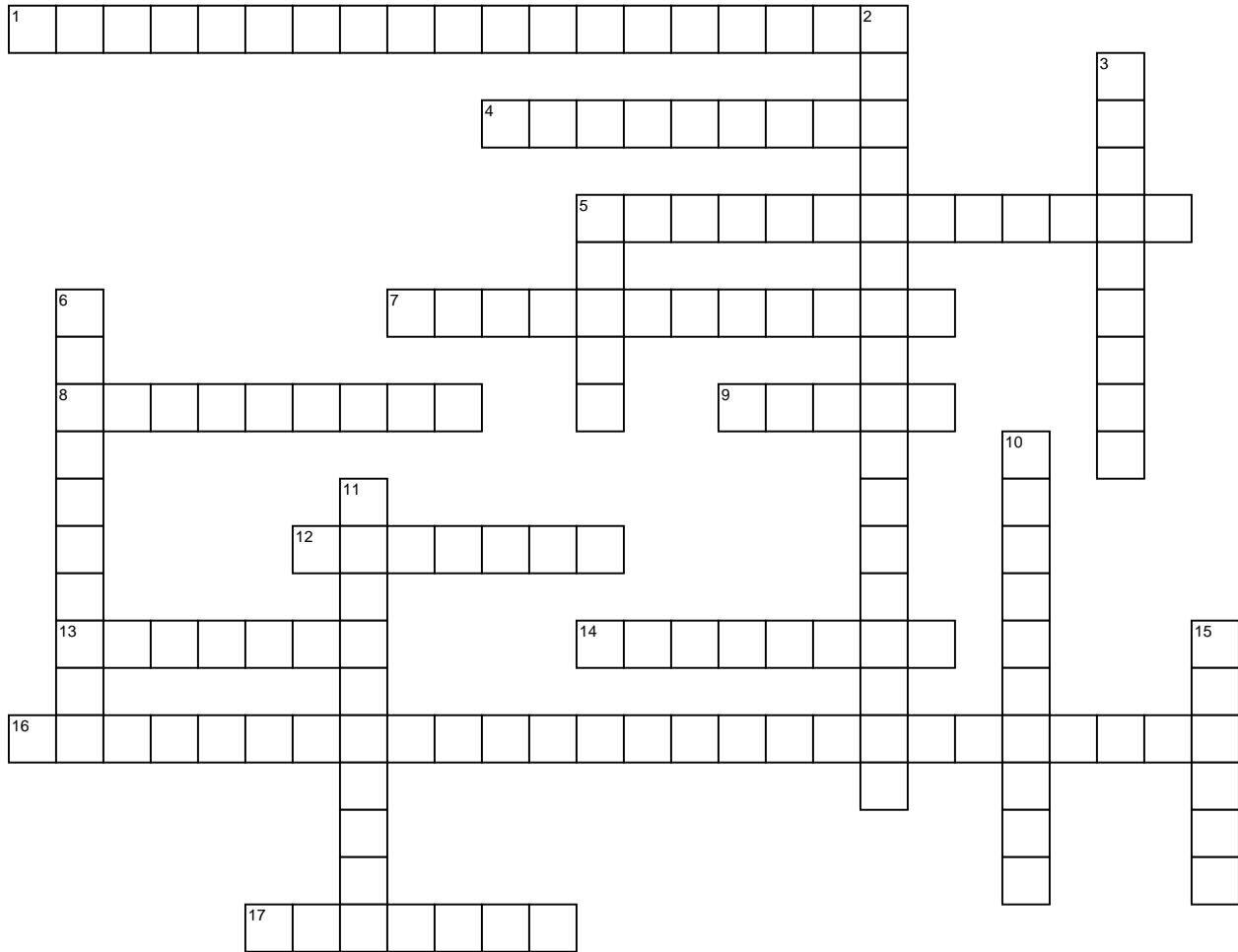


Vaccine Preventable Diseases

ACROSS

- 1 A cause of cervical cancer
- 4 Itchy and blistering disease; commonly called chickenpox
- 5 An infection of the fluid surrounding the brain and spinal cord; could be fatal within 24 hours
- 7 Common cause of severe lung infection and ear infections in young children
- 8 In 2008 Clark County had over 70 cases of this disease; also known as Whooping Cough
- 9 A crippling disease that is still prevalent in other countries including India and regions of West Africa
- 12 Cause of lock jaw
- 13 This disease can cause miscarriages or serious birth defects
- 14 You can only develop this disease if you have had chickenpox disease in the past
- 16 A vaccine against this disease became available in 1985 and prevents a type of meningitis
- 17 In 2008 there was an increase in cases of this disease in the US due to under-vaccination; fine red rash, high fever, eye irritation

DOWN

- 2 Most likely to occur in Ohio between October and March of each year; causes 36,000 deaths in the US every year
- 3 Causes severe diarrhea in small children
- 5 Swelling of glands in the cheeks, jaw and neck
- 6 This disease is a bacterial infection that spreads easily and occurs quickly; it mainly affects the nose and throat causing a thick fuzzy gray or black coating.
- 10 A serious disease that affects the liver and can lead to liver cancer
- 11 Disease can be acquired through contaminated food or water
- 15 Disease can be transmitted through bites from infected bats or animals
