SHA/SHIP CHA/CHIP HBHS last review Timeline to review Re-fine goals?	<p>A new State Health Assessment (SHA) was recently completed and subsequently a State Health Improvement Plan (SHIP) was created (2017). The state of Ohio's SHA/SHIP is typically reflective of a community's Community Health Assessment (CHA) and Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP). Communities are asked to keep their eye on aligning CHIP goals with the SHIP. We reviewed the timeline of our current goals and discussed making some small revision so that we can get some of the objectives completed. Clark County Teen Births, Sexual Activity and STD rates report	<p>Anna Jean Petroff, CCCHD epidemiologist answered questions about this report. All were appreciative of Anna Jean's work as we can now easily compare variables over time. Leslie asked if we can tweak a couple of questions in future surveys so that info is more clear. These considerations will be applied next assessment. Data of the latest YRBS survey should be available in Feb, 2018. Anna Jean will be sharing those results with stakeholders and we will all be provided the info as it becomes available.</p>	<p>Page 1- Anna Jean will pull data for births of those who are 13-18.</p> <p>Page 9- she will flip bar graphs so that timeline goes from 2011-2015.</p> <p>Other: can STI</p>

Infant Mortality Report	<p>Anna Jean Petroff, CCCHD epidemiologist answered questions about this report. Group interested in other risk factors for mothers and birth as prematurity (and complications of) continues to be the leading cause of deaths (state and local).</p> <p>Other factors for consideration: hypertension, obesity, drug, tobacco, alcohol use, low income, lack of prenatal care, race. Group asked to bring forth any other variables they wish to be added.</p>	<p>Lori will send out latest state of OH IM report for reference.</p> <p>Anna Jean will look at local data over a few years of all births so that group can determine if there are interventions the group wishes to consider based on those findings.</p>
Next Steps	<p>Brainstorming around next steps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Using same format of directory of services guide for prenatal services, adapt it so a person can easily identify where one can obtain birth control and help with an STI.
