

## Hepatitis A Case Statistics: 4/4/2019

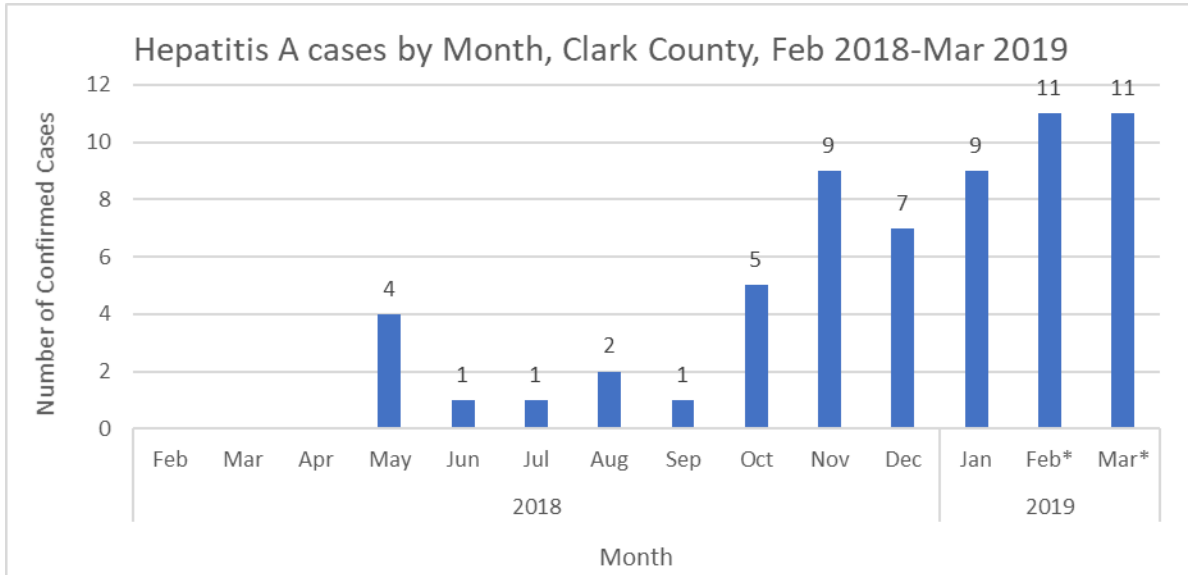


Figure 2: Confirmed hepatitis A cases by month in Clark County, Ohio, from February 2018 to February 2019. Data queried from Ohio Disease Reporting System on 4/4/2019. \*February and March data is preliminary and is subject to change.

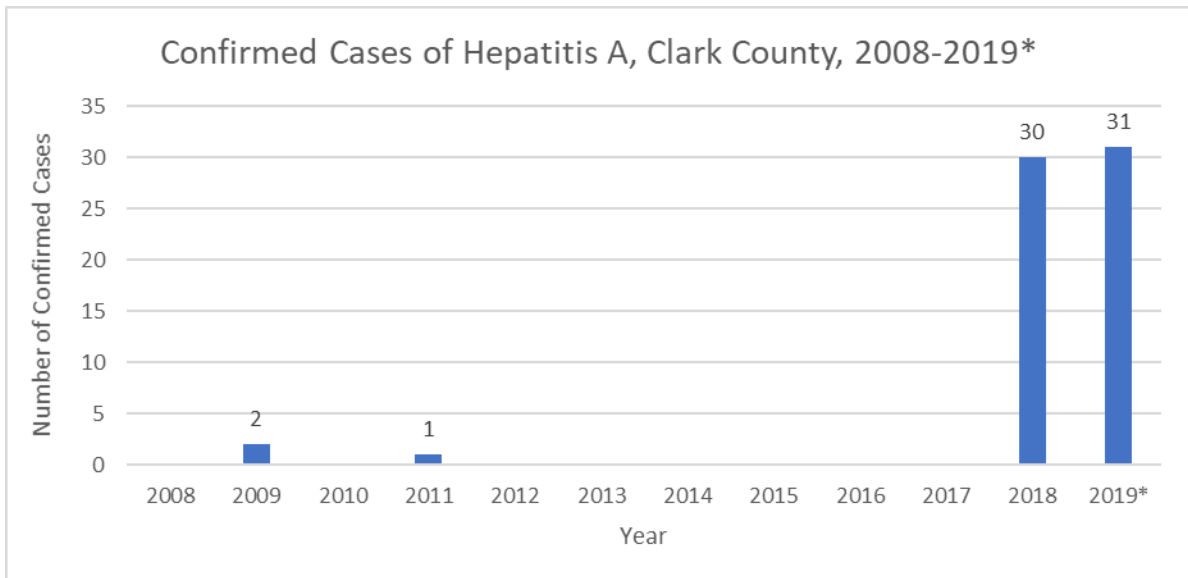


Figure 1: Confirmed hepatitis A cases by year in Clark County, Ohio, 2008-2019. Data queried from Ohio Disease Reporting System on 4/4/2019. \*2019 data is preliminary and is subject to change.

As of 4/4/2019, the Clark County Combined Health District has investigated 61 confirmed cases of hepatitis A since the beginning of 2018 (Figure 1). The last confirmed case of hepatitis A in Clark County was in 2011 (Figure 2). In 2018, CCCHD investigated 30 confirmed cases of hepatitis A. As of 4/4/2019, the total number of hepatitis A cases in Clark County in 2019 has surpassed the 2018 total (Figure 2).

9 cases are confirmed as “CA Cluster A, 1B,” which is the strain currently circulating in Kentucky and West Virginia outbreaks.
