Congestive Heart Failure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 6 patients with CHF have been referred since January 1, 2019 - 4 patients have established care (3 out of the 4 patients were uninsured when they went to Rocking Horse) - 2 no shows - Average days from the hospital referral to Rocking Horse is about 5.5 days 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Continue to reach out to those in the community and establish care for those who may need it.

This will be re-scheduled to February 7th.
