The criteria to be released from isolation is at least 3 days (72 hours) fever-free and improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.

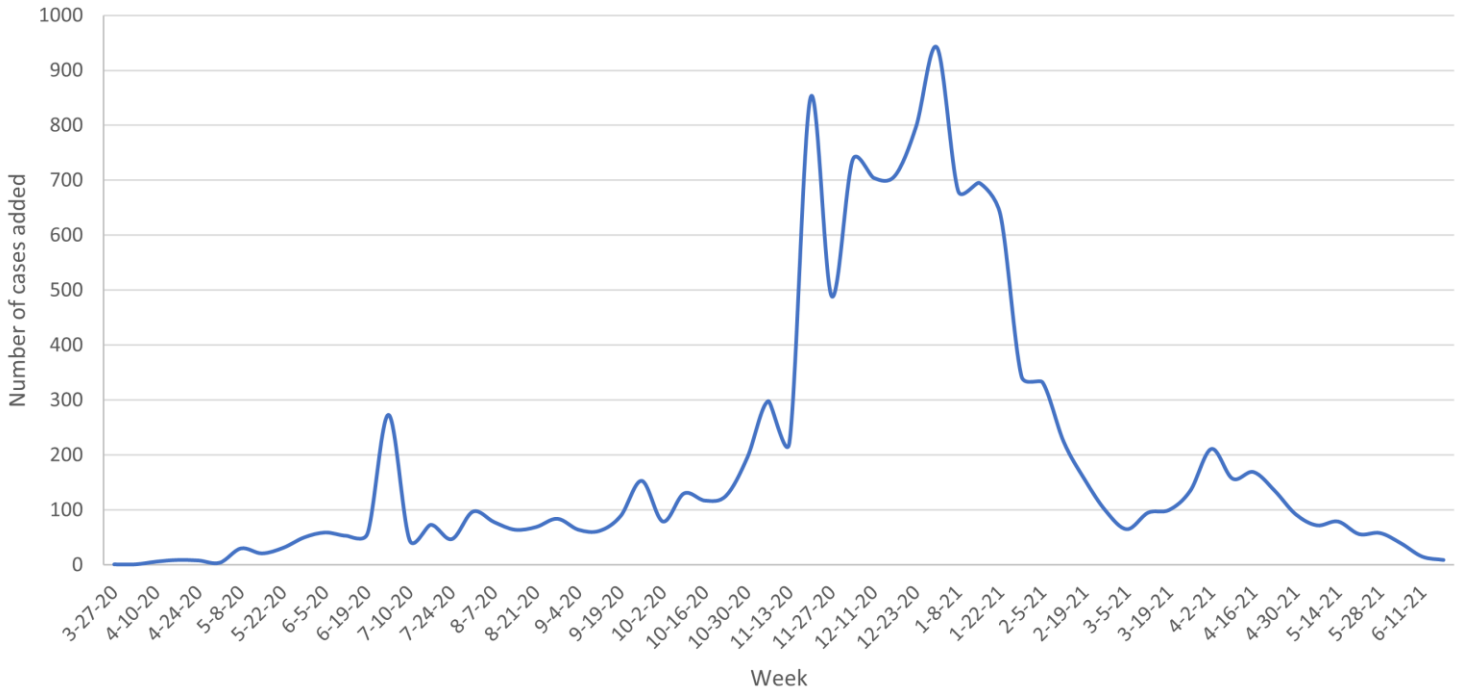
