<b>Review of Work Plan</b>	<b>Impact Objective #1:</b> Decrease in teen birth rate. Joan suggested that a revised time line be considered rather than March 2019. Agreed that an interim date is preferable. Objective includes the use of a questionnaire for the schools to learn current status of sexual health education in city and county schools. <b>Presentation to Superintendents</b>	Group discussed the notion of presenting questionnaire / survey results to area superintendents. Goal is for the schools to become aware of reproductive health education options and to share information about what each is doing. All agreed that visiting the superintendents' monthly meeting was a good idea. Leslie offered that she will be attending this meeting regularly beginning with the coming school year, and will have an opportunity to introduce the idea to the group. <b>Articles on emotional and psychological impact of adolescent sexuality</b>	Ellen Dudney asked the group for responses to the articles she shared by email. Copies were distributed to the group and discussed. Ellen suggested that the group continue to pursue accurate information about the risks of teen sexuality. Group discussed the role of parents in communicating their own family values regarding sexuality, and how this might fit in with the work plan. Decision made to incorporate equipping parents with information under Impact Objective #1. See work plan.	Added objective to IO #1	N/A
<b>Prenatal Care</b>	Discussed Impact Objective #2 – early initiation of prenatal care. Ohio rate is 73.6% for first trimester pn care. Clark's rate is 57% according to ODH 2015 stats. HP 2020 goal is 77%. Agreed that we would set as a goal, a 30% increase in first trimester pn care, which results in a rate of 74% by March 2019, consistent with Ohio's rate. <b>Impact Objective #3 – Minority populations</b>	Discussion regarding IO #3. Agreed that we would identify additional vulnerable populations in need of sexual health information and services, to include people who are homeless, incarcerated, developmentally delayed, in recovery from addiction, or with chronic mental health issues, and address the needs of these populations in IO #3.
